Advanced Stages . In advanced heart failure, the heart no longer pumps enough blood, either because the heart cannot fill up with enough blood or can't pump forcefully enough to meet the body's needs. The heart still beats, but it is weak and damaged. Even more, the body is unable to compensate for the reduced blood the heart can pump.
