Hofstede's cultural dimensions theory is a framework for cross-cultural communication, developed by Geert Hofstede. It shows the effects of a society's culture on the values of its members, and how these values relate to behaviour, using a structure derived from factor analysis.

Cultural competence is defined as the ability to work effectively with people from different cultural backgrounds. Cultural competence is comprised of four components or aspects: a diplomatic mindset, agile cultural learning, reasoning about other cultures, and; a disciplined approach to intercultural interactions.

For example, Germany has a 35 on the cultural scale of Hofstede's analysis. Compared to Arab countries where the power distance is very high (80) and Austria where it very low (11), Germany is somewhat in the middle. Germany does not have a large gap between the wealthy and the poor, but have a strong belief in equality for each citizen.

The main cultural risks facing global businesses include: 1. Failing to adapt global business models to the local market. Consumer attitudes and behaviours are highly influenced by culture.
