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How To Sew Leather Suede

Use a 14 gauge needle for thin to medium weight leathers, and 16 to 18 for heavier skins. Seams can be pressed out as you sew; use a pressing cloth and the lowest heat possible on thinner leathers. To flatten a seam in a heavier skin, open the fabric and place heavy, flat weight (books or boards are good) on the seam.

Working With Suede

Use polyester or nylon thread. If you want your topstitching to stand out, use a heavy weight 100% Polyester heavy weight thread. 3. Attach a leather needle to your sewing machine. A leather needle is extra sharp and designed for suede/leather sewing. I like to use a size 18 needle for mid weight

To sew leather by hand, start by gluing the edges you'll be stitching together and using an over-stitching wheel to mark your stitches. Next, punch holes through the stitching marks with an awl, clamp the leather into a lacing pony, and knot the ends of your thread onto 2 separate needles.

Simply apply a line of tape between the two pieces of leather you want to sew, placing the tape along the edge of your leather, within what will be the seam allowance. Then sew your seam, and the tape will remain inside the seam allowance (no need to try to remove it).
