### The Role of the Nurse and the Preoperative Assessment in ...

There are number of factors which contribute for effective postoperative pain management such as a structured acute management team, patient education, regular staff training, use of balanced analgesia, regular pain assessment tools and adjustment of strategies to meet the needs of special patient groups. Women require less analgesia than men.

### CLINICAL ASPECTS OF ACUTE POST-OPERATIVE PAIN MANAGEMENT ...

Preoperative instruction should include information about the pain management method that they will utilize postoperatively. Patients should be encouraged to ask for or take pain medication before the pain becomes unbearable, and should be taught how to rate their discomfort on a pain scale.

### Preoperative Care - procedure, recovery, blood, removal ...

Available preoperative parameters for multivariate analysis were age, clinical TNM stage, Gleason score from biopsy specimen (categorical), PSA (categorically divided into 4 or less, 4.1 to 10, 10.1 to 20 and greater than 20 ng/ml) and acid phosphatase level.
